Salmon Fishing from Balmacara to Plockton has been sold  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. When it was sold</li><li>2. To whom it was sold</li></ol>
<b>Response</b>
<p>The stretch of salmon fishing rights from Balmacara to Plockton (Rubha Mor) were sold to the Atlantic Salmon Conservation Trust (Scotland) in 2004.</p> <p>The salmon fishing at Plockton itself were found not to belong to the Crown in 1877 following an investigation into a claim by Sir Alexander Mathieson.</p> <p>We do not have any further information on these salmon fishing rights other than that they are not considered to be within Crown ownership since the dates indicated above.
