

## **Tenant service charter**

We want to deliver the best possible service to our tenants. Our 2017-20 corporate plan sets out our intention to establish tenant service principles (or a 'charter'), outlining what tenants can expect from Crown Estate Scotland in terms of service and ethos.

The following tenant service charter for Crown Estate Scotland is founded on our core values (collaboration, integrity, commercialism, excellence) and

- The findings of independent research carried out with tenants in rural, aquaculture and coastal in late 2017 (specifically tenants' desire for us to respond quickly to requests regarding repairs on the rural estate, to be open with them e.g. about how rents are set, and to continue to communicate pro-actively about what Crown Estate Scotland does now and our plans for the future)
- Findings from independent research into energy & infrastructure tenants' views carried out by The Crown Estate in 2015-16 (in particular, feedback that they value our collaborative approach and our ability to bring people to the table, our strategic activity and responsible, long-term view)
- A review of customer service principles / commitments from other businesses and other sectors including developers, property management companies, retailers and banks to help ensure we are learning from others and not too narrow in our ambition or perspective.

The 'charter' is structured according to our four core values as part of our commitment across the business to continue to 'live and breathe' our values.
