The following pages provide simplified **examples of projects which the fund might support**. It's important to stress that **they aren't an exhaustive list**.

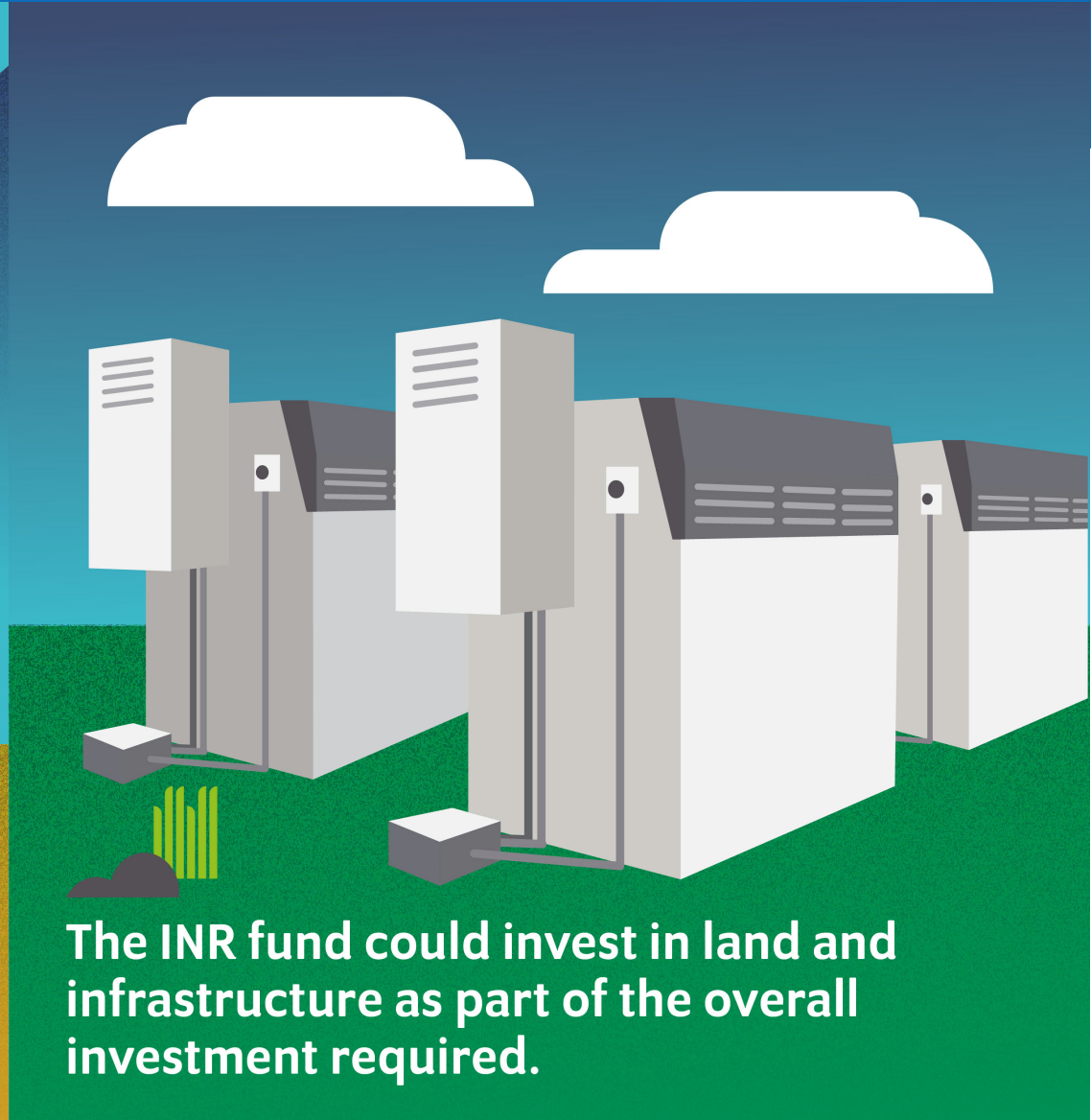

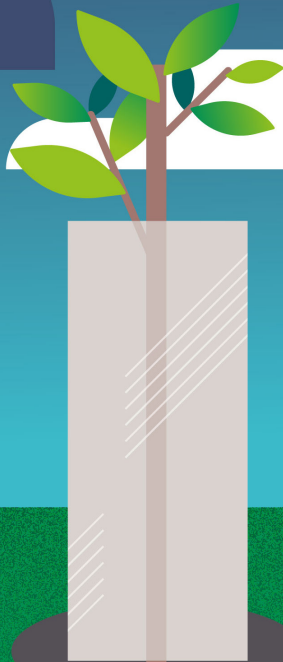
# Example 1: **Marine energy**



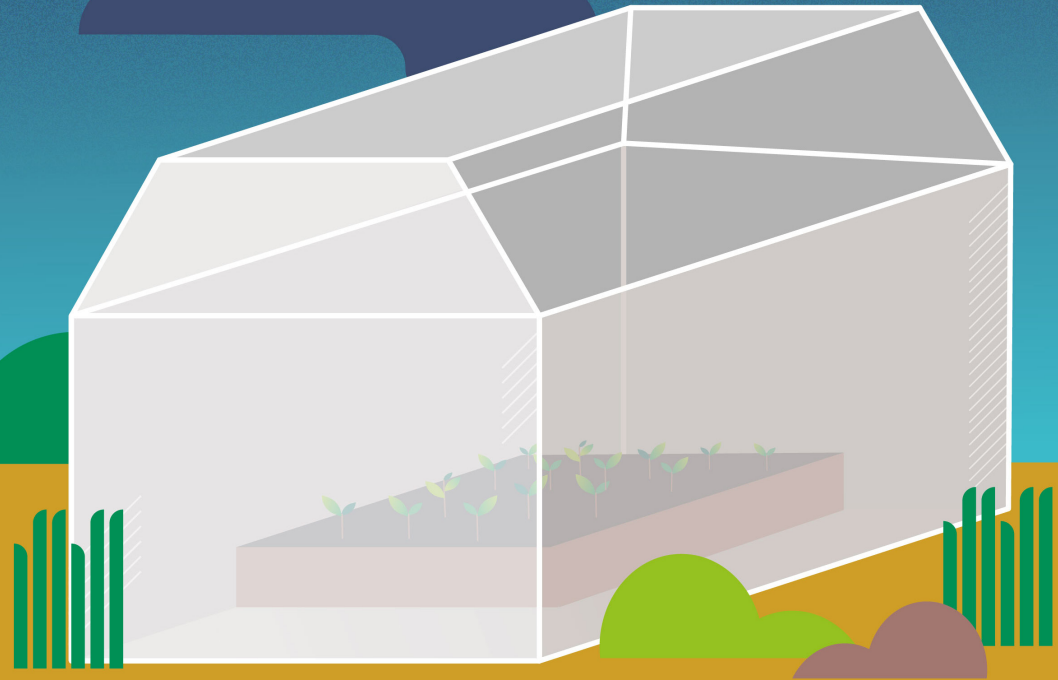

A Crown Estate Scotland tenant farmer wants to diversify their business by developing a tree nursery.

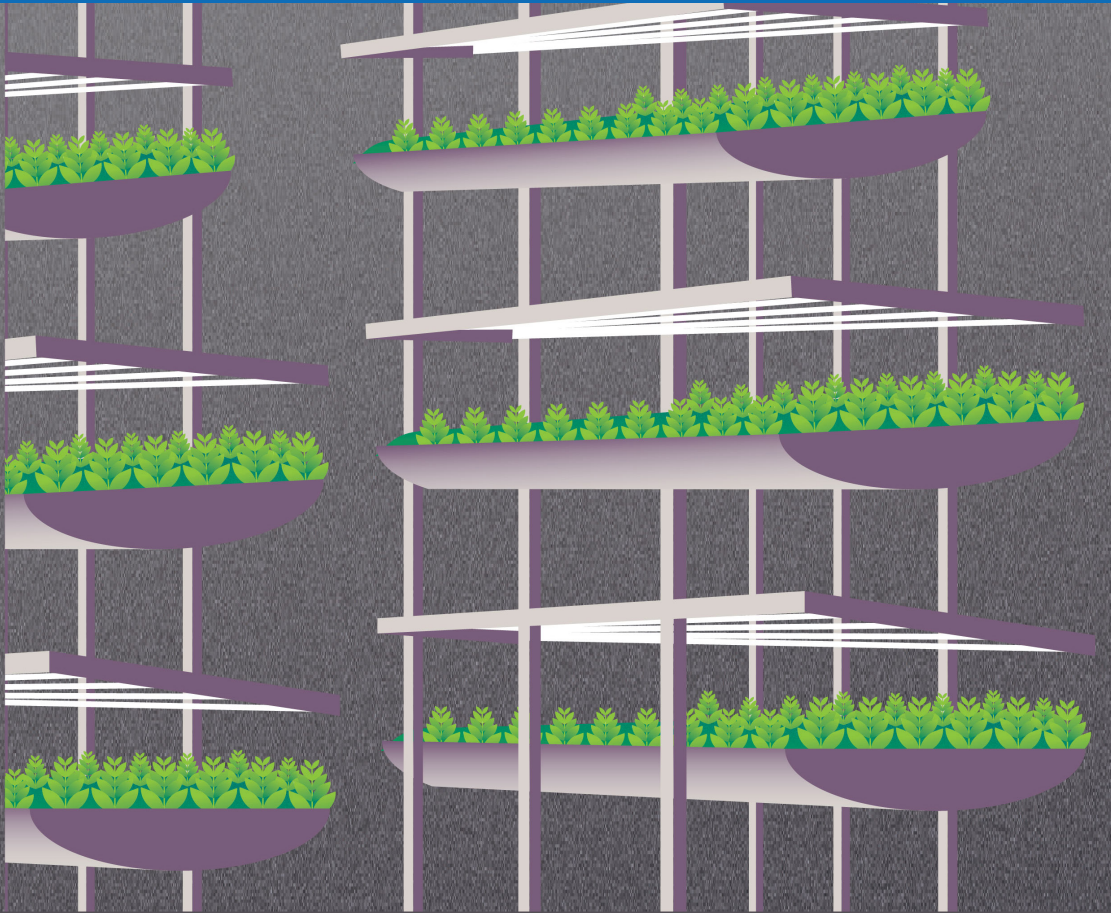


The INR fund can provide investment in the construction of greenhouses and staff facilities to support the new venture.
