We have some preliminary outputs from Aurora – only one of the five task areas, and a few aspects of what they have provided where I have given a bit of a steer / raised further questions. Despite the preliminary nature, I wondered whether it would be helpful for [REDACTED] to see this, to help align anything being set up with Strathclyde / get any preliminary insights he might have about steering the work to increase the chances of it covering what will be of priority for Ministers. (In view of tight timescales, there is unlikely to be the change to redirect the Aurora work very much, but provided it is understood that there are limits on what we can change now, it would still be helpful to get whatever steer [REDACTED] might have.)

I have attached the first-cut Aurora slides in the first email, and my initial response back to them – happy for both to go forward to [REDACTED], although with the strong caveat that this is just early work in progress we are sharing to help alignment, rather than deliverables that ought to be used for wider discussion just yet.
